International Communication Management

As an international communication professional, you'll make a real difference for a multinational or NGO anywhere in the world.

Do you want to build a career in the international communication field? Study in a diverse, international classroom and achieve a lot in a short time? Do you have the ambition to tackle complex communication challenges? Then the three-year English-taught bachelor's programme International Communication Management at The Hague University of Applied Sciences is the right choice for you.

This programme is unique. Not only because it is intensive and fast-paced, but also because you'll work on real projects for international companies. Alongside this hands-on experience, you'll gain the theoretical knowledge needed to build a solid foundation in communication. From as early as the third semester, you can go abroad to broaden your horizons and deepen your expertise.

After three years, you will graduate as an internationally oriented communication professional who can make a genuine impact. Whether for a multinational, a globally operating NGO, or any other organisation that relies on your expertise.

Admission requirements

Entry advice

The International Communication Management program is fully English-taught and lasts three years. Admission normally requires a vwo diploma or equivalent. Admission requirements – Three-year bachelor's programme

Admission requirements

- Dutch havo diploma – not eligible
- Dutch vwo diploma – all profiles eligible
- Dutch mbo diploma – not eligible

To qualify for the three-year programme, you need one of the following:

- Dutch VWO diploma (all profiles eligible)
- Propaedeutic certificate from a Dutch research university
- Bachelor's degree Propaedeutic certificate from a Dutch university of applied sciences, if:
 - it is from the same or a related programme
 - it was obtained within one year
 - you achieved a minimum GPA of 7.0

Example: If you completed the propaedeutic year (P) of Communication with an average grade of 7 or higher, you can apply for the first year of International Communication Management (ICM). To do this, submit your application via Studielink. Student Services will then contact you.

What will you do?

Year 1 – Introduction to International Communication

You will collaborate with international classmates on global challenges and communication projects. In semester 1, you focus on communication in organisations and society. Semester 2 has a creative twist, exploring marketing and design thinking.

Semester 3 is all about broadening your knowledge in topics related to management and organisation. You can do that either by means of an international exchange at one of our partner universities in or outside Europe, or by means of following a minor in the Netherlands.

In semester 4, you apply your skills in a real project for the

Municipality of The Hague, the International City of Peace and Justice.

Year 3 – Specialisation & Graduation



Tuition fees and funding

Tuition fees for subsidized higher education are set by the Dutch Ministry of Education. You need to pay the tuition fee before you can be (re-)enrolled. You can pay the full

amount in one transaction via your bank, but there are also options for instalments. Please note that administration costs are charged for payment in instalments. Stay up to date on the latest tuition fee information. Also take into account additional costs such as books and other study materials.

Student finance
