

English language requirements

As our international master programs are entirely taught in English, candidates must demonstrate a good command of the English language: speaking, listening, reading and writing. Students are required to hand in a valid and sufficient English level test result.

We accept the following English level tests: IELTS, TOEIC, TOEFL and Cambridge

- No other English language test is accepted;
- The test date may not be older than two years on 1 September 2024;
- Language tests must be taken at a test centre. We don't accept the TOEFL iBT Home Edition.

Exemptions

You may be exempted for the English level test, if the following applies:

- You obtained a bachelor's degree in the Netherlands
- Your bachelor's program was entirely taught in English

If we have reason to doubt your English proficiency, you may be asked to provide an additional English language test.

Part-time students currently working in an international (English spoken) environment for at least 2 years, can qualify for a possible exemption on the English level test. This will be assessed during the mandatory intake interview.
