


Click on **Bibits**.

Zuiderpark Sports Campus
The Zuiderpark Sports Campus is a staffed library with a collection in the field of sports, education and sports management. The P.O. physical education teacher (sporting), Sports Science and International Sports Management are located here.

Delft
The Delft site is an unstaffed library with a basic collection of books and journals on IT and technology. In addition you will find there is a self-service section for the borrowing and return of materials and a few places where you can work quietly.

Zoetermeer
The Zoetermeer site is an unstaffed library with a basic collection of books and journals on IT and technology, a self-service section for the borrowing and return of materials and a few places where you can read quietly. You can also copy and print here.

Searching for your book or other materials in the catalogue

To find out which materials you can find at the library, just consult the catalogue. In the catalogue, you can see whether an item is in the rack, where it can be found in the rack and whether it is available or has been loaned out.
