English language requirements

As our international Master programmes are taught entirely in English, candidates must demonstrate a good command of the English language, both spoken and written. Students are required to hand in a valid and sufficient English level test result.

We accept the following English level tests: TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS and Cambridge.

- No other English language test is accepted
- The IELTS, TOEFL and TOEIC certificates are valid for two years
- The certificate must be valid at the start of the academic year

You may be exempted for the English level test, if the following applies:

- You are educated in the Netherlands

- Your previous education was entirely taught in English. If we have reason to doubt your English proficiency, you may be asked to provide an additional IELTS/TOEFL

Part-time students currently working in an international (English spoken) environment for at least 2 years can qualify for a possible exemption on the English level test. This will be assessed during the mandatory intake interview.
